



Looking at our programming for 2016

New Life Radio staff and listener reports



A TIME FOR CHANGE and new beginnings is the subject of this CRFR newsletter issue as we announce the official changeover in ownership from NLR's founding media entity to a newly-created mass media organization. This action was taken to comply with Russian media laws against foreign media ownership.

On April 1, 2016, the Russian state media agency, *Roskomnadzor,* issued a mass media license to a Moscow-based non-profit organization founded by leaders of four evangelical mission groups that have long partnered with CRFR. Led by NLR station manager, Dmitri Vatoulya, the new ministry will take over the legal management of the radio network and staff from Daniel Johnson, who ends his trusteeship after organizing New Life Radio in 1996.

This move will better position the *New Life Satellite Network* to legally continue Gospel broadcasts despite ongoing restrictions against the Evangelical church and press inside Russia. CRFR will continue to provide the financial support of the network, placing programming efforts under the domain of the new ministry founders. Dmitri V.

The radio ministry is in strong hands, but we ask for your continued prayer!

Looking at NLSN programming in 2016: giving a voice to those called to preach, teach, and encourage

Since our beginning, we have featured the most trusted Bible teachers from Russia and the USA to disciple young believers while challenging the unbeliever with the claims of Christ.

Our radio format targets an audience range of 16 to 45, featuring 70% contemporary Christian music, 25% Bible teaching and Christian drama, and 5% news and discussion programs of relevance to the Christian community. NLSN reaches their audience via satellite radio on HOTBIRD, two FM affiliates, and Internet radio at **www.NLRadio.net**

New Life offers its airwaves for free to the leaders of evangelical denominations and ministries, in order to provide them access to a national audience that has few options to hear Christian content in secular media. Alexei Smirnov



Despite its very contemporary format, listeners can hear mature Biblical instruction from both elder and youthful ministers who share the timeless message of NEW LIFE in Christ.



Current program titles like Honest Talk; Dialog; Gift of the Reformation; Through the Eyes of a Teenager; What Women Want; Cultural Library; Editor's Column; Word on Word; 140 years of the Bible in Russia (focusing on the impact of the Synodal translation of the Scriptures on Russia)

add to the overall mix of programming that seeks to impart a solid understanding of the Christian faith along with mastery of Scripture through constant, short readings on the air between songs. It is small bits of Christian information across the day, along with great music and relevant materials that keep the NLSN listener tuned in, interested and growing in their faith.

Challenges and opportunities for Christian radio inside of Russia in 2016

With the development of our new non-profit media company, our Russian co-founders now have the challenge to find ways to get our broadcasts into even more ministry outlets and locations. While the Kremlin is working to squelch all independent media, including the recent closure of two Christian AM radio stations in Moscow and St. Petersburg (Radio TEOS), our call to proclaim the Gospel drives us to seek new ways to assist the evangelical Church that needs the resource of Christian radio to support local outreach activities--even across many nations that we can reach by satellite & Internet radio.

Another challenge we hope to meet in 2016 is to get back to full satellite radio coverage of Russia, in order to provide signals to communities across the Urals, Siberia, and the Far East regions that will never have local Christian radio. Our goal is \$3,000 a month for this satellite coverage.

Pray for our new founders: Dmitri Vatoulya; Alexei Zolotarev (representing *Reach Beyond*); Nadia Zakirova (representing *Russian Christian Radio*; and Sergey Sipko (VP of the *Russian Baptist Union*). CRFR will work with them to insure the financing of the radio network while they develop closer interaction with evangelical churches across the country to utilize and contribute to the radio programming of NLSN.
