Investing for the future of Christian radio to Russia and Ukraine: NLR seeks a place of its own

2024 was a challenging yet rewarding year for the missionaries at New Life Radio in Odessa. Coming off a wonderful Christmas season program schedule full of outstanding Bible teaching, festive and celebrative music, and reviews from listeners of growing in their faith, our radio team is excited about the prospects we have to increase our presence and influence for Christ in communities across Russia and Ukraine in 2025.

While the war and attacks on Odessa continue, new challenges for our audience in both countries are giving us opportunities to provide an ongoing witness for the Lord using technology and methods that can overcome restrictions these people face every day. Because we know the power of God's Word, and His directive to share the Gospel globally, it is with a sense of assurance that NLR can tackle all the obstacles they are now facing this month. In this issue, we will outline some of these that you may pray about and consider how to help as God directs you.



Time for a new home.

In the last newsletter we reported on our attempts while in Odessa to negotiate with the University NLR rents from, to resolve the lack of gas heating in the building, as well as installing solar panels to help alleviate the station from the daily city power outages due to the war. Sadly, we were unable to solve the problems, with no prospect to improve the general condition of the building and its utilities. The facility remains unheated and has become run down, while zoning issues prevents

NLR from independently obtaining separate utility services. Its difficult enough for our staff to contend with operational problems each day, but dealing with the uncertainties of this old building forces us to seek alternatives in order to give them the best working conditions we can provide.

It has been 30 years since NLR began their radio broadcast efforts to the former Soviet Union, and all this time without a permanent home. From renting two rooms for their first site in Magadan, Russia in 1994, to their next studio on Red Square in Moscow and a production center in central Moscow, NLR has been at the whim of its various landlords that eventually forced them out of their facilities for a variety of reasons both financial and space related. This is the 4th time NLR has faced expulsion.

To provide for them, a Capital campaign to raise \$150,000 has begun

CRFRU's board of directors have authorized this fundraising effort with the following parameters:

- Preference to purchase an office space in Odessa with 5 to 7 rooms that can properly house two separate radio networks along with office & kitchen, with options to install solar generators to offset the expected 250% increase in electric rates that NLR's organization will be paying.
- Maintain an option for purchasing a home in the city to house NLR or purchase land outside Odessa that is suitable for building a small facility.
- 3. CRFRU estimates a minimum price of \$150,000 for an office space purchase plus additional renovation for six radio studios. Setting a goal of raising this amount by March 2025, and offsetting funds needed for the renovation with existing resources, we feel we can get NLR into a new home by summer of 2025, Lord willing. The time has come to give NLR the stability they need to broadcast for the long term in their own facility, while keeping their operating costs low.

In January 2025, RUSSIA has greatly increased restrictions on the Internet and press access from the West, shutting down independent websites accessible within the country including Facebook, YouTube, and a million more. Citizens must register their private information before being given new access to social media and email. In essence, a police state scenario has reestablished itself and users can be imprisoned for comments deemed harmful to state interests. With this heightened federal control that has limited the ability for evangelical Christians to promote the faith over the Russian media, the need for an independent source of programming is greatly increased, and NLR can meet this via its satellite radio broadcasts over the *Hotbird* 13 satellite. To maintain our Internet radio links globally, we use servers in Finland and Amsterdam.

This warning is very appropriate today, for false teaching in the name of Jesus is rampant today as never before, ranging from subtle heresies to flagrant denial of His divine and human nature."

NLR is extremely focused on sound doctrine and correct interpretation of the Bible (*Scripture interprets Scripture in context*), knowing that many in our audience have not had access to proper teaching and instruction, and there is much disunity and confusion in the Slavic church as a result. Please pray for this aspect of our ministry to Russia and Ukraine, and for God to send us the very best teachers of His Word for us to broadcast!
